Intealth[®] is authorized by the U.S. Department of State to sponsor foreign national physicians for the J-1 Exchange Visitor visa for the purpose of participating in U.S. programs of graduate medical education or training.

In 2025, Intealth sponsored 17,486 J-1 physicians in U.S. GME.

J-1 physicians train and serve in high numbers in primary-care specialties, including Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, and Family Medicine.

This means that J-1 physicians frequently are among our frontline providers.
